- Additional levels will be added as needed.

- \$400 buy-in (\$330 prize pool + \$70 administrative fee) Players start with 15,000 tournament chips. Registration open until start of level 9.
- \$600 buy-in (\$515 prize pool + \$85 administrative fee) Players start with 20,000 tournament chips. Registration open until start of level 13.
- If scheduled as a Monster Stack, Players start with 30,000 in tournament chips. Registration will remain open until start of level 13.
- Administrative fee includes any and all staffing/dealer fees, and rake.
- Eliminated players may re-enter all original fees apply. Players must have zero (0) chips remaining to re-enter.
- Players may forfeit or surrender their chips to re-enter.
- A player who has not taken a hand by the start of the first break may be considered a "no show" and have their chips removed from play and may not be eligible to participate and may not be eligible for a refund.
- This tournament is scheduled as two-day tournament. The Tournament Director in their sole and absolute discretion may adjust the break schedule, adjust the start and stop time, adjust the level lengths, and/or add an additional day if necessary.
- There will be a 15-minute break approximately every 2 hours of play and a 60-minute dinner break after 6 hours of play.
- Day 1 will play until the completion of level 24, unless otherwise announced by the tournament staff.
- Day 2 will resume at 2:00 PM on the following day.
- Players will qualify to earn points for the WSOP Global Casino Championship and the Winner receives a WSOP Circuit Ring.
