- *Additional levels will be added as needed.*

- **Fees:** \$70 buy-in (\$50 prize pool + \$20 administration). 3% of the total prize pool withheld for tournament staffing.  
\$250 buy-in (\$200 prize pool + \$50 administration). 3% of the total prize pool withheld for tournament staffing *(for High Roller)*
- **Prizes\*:** An entry into the designated "ring" event plus \$20 cash will be awarded for each time that amount is divisible into the prize pool.  
*(Example: designated ring event buy-in is \$400, then a \$400 entry and \$20 cash will be awarded for every \$420 in the prize pool)*
- Remaining money in the prize pool will be distributed to the next highest placing participant.
- Players will start with 3,000 in tournament chips.
- Registration will remain open for 6 levels, eliminated players may re-enter until this time at the registration counter. All original fees apply. Players must have zero (0) chips remaining to re-enter. Players may forfeit or surrender their chips to re-enter.
- Any player who has not taken a hand by the close registration may be considered a "no show" and may have their chips removed from play and may not be eligible to participate and may not be eligible for a refund.
- This tournament is scheduled as one-day tournament. The Tournament Director in his sole and absolute discretion may adjust the break schedule, adjust the start and stop time, and adjust the level lengths.
