• Fees: \$130 buy-in (\$100 prize pool + \$30 administration) 3% of the total prize pool withheld for tournament staffing.

- 10a/12pm starts: 10,000 in tournament chips. 30-min levels. Registration open until start of level 9. 60-min dinner after 12 levels. 1-day*
- Double Stacks: 20,000 in tournament chips. 30-min levels. Registration open until start of level 12. 60-min dinner after 12 levels. 2-day*
- Monster Stacks: 25,000 in tournament chips. 30-min levels. Registration open until start of level 12. 60-min dinner after 12 levels. 2-day*
- Triple Stacks: 30,000 in tournament chips. 30-min levels. Registration open until start of level 12. 60-min dinner after 12 levels. 2-day*
- 2pm/3pm starts: 10,000 in tournament chips. 20-min levels. Registration open until start of level 9. 30-min dinner after 12 levels. 1-day*
- 5pm starts: 6,000 in tournament chips. 20-min levels. Registration open until start of level 7.
- Eliminated players may re-enter until registration closes. Players must have zero (0) chips remaining to re-enter. Players may forfeit or surrender chips to re-enter. Any player who has not taken a hand by the start of the first break may be considered a "no show" and may have their chips removed from play and may not be eligible to participate and may not be eligible for a refund.
- There will be a break approximately every 2 hours of play.
- If scheduled as a "Bounty" the players are required to have their bounty chip on the table at all times. Bounties are awarded to the winner of the pot in which a player is eliminated from the tournament.
- Scheduled "Seniors" tournaments are open to all players 50 years of age or older. "Ladies" tournaments are open to female players.
- The Tournament Director in their sole and absolute discretion may adjust the break schedule, adjust the start and stop time, adjust the level lengths, and/or add an additional day if necessary.
