The PokerGO Cup is a series of 8 events. The player who wins the most PokerGO Tour points during the series will win the PokerGO Cup and the \$50K championship bonus.

General Rules for All Events:

1. Players must be in the registration line by 12 pm sharp to qualify for the discount.
2. Late entries and re-entries will pay the designated tournament fee.
3. Events 1-7 are double re-entry. The 100K event is single re-entry.
4. Levels are 40 minutes with a 10-minute break every 2 levels. All events are two days.
5. Tables are seated 8-handed and switch to 7-handed once registration closes.
6. The poker shot clock is 30 seconds with six 30-second time banks each day. Unused time banks can be used the next day. The final 6 players will receive 6 additional time banks.
7. Entry is open through level 6. Unofficial final tables are 9-handed.
8. Players will play down to the final 6 or midnight. Day 2 starts at 12 pm.
9. Players at the featured table are required to place their hole cards in the RFID box at the start of each hand. Featured tables will have at least a 30-minute broadcast delay.
10. Players must be 21 years of age to participate.
11. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding.
12. Management reserves the right to change or cancel tournaments.
