

\$100 No-Limit Hold'em Chip Chop Survivor

- This tournament will run at 2:00 PM on Wednesday, & Saturday.
- 2. Registration will open two (2) hour prior to the start of the tournament and close at the beginning of the seventh level after tournament begins ("entry fee period").
- 3. The entry fee is \$100. \$78 to the prize pool. \$11 house fee, \$10 to the staff, and \$1 to promo.
- 4. Players will begin with 20,000 in tournament chips.
- 5. Blind levels will be 15 minutes in length and feature a Big Blind Ante structure. (see rule 13)
- 6. Play will halt after the end of level 11. Any remaining tables will play one more round with all remaining players having the Big Blind one time. After the conclusion of the final round the tournament will be considered finished.
- 7. At the conclusion of the tournament, all players still in play will be awarded a sum of \$100 and a proportional share of the remaining prize pool, calculated as their chip
- stack percentage versus the total chips in play. So, if you hold 10% of the chips, you will receive 10% of the remaining prize pool. Once registration closes, if one player has accumulated all of the chips in play, they will receive 100% of the prize pool.
- 8. This tournament will feature a payout guarantee of \$3,000. The guarantee will be considered met when the total amount of money paid out is equal to or greater than the guarantee.
- 9. A player losing all of their chips may re-enter the tournament for an additional \$100. They will receive 20,000 in tournament chips. Players may re-enter until the start of level 7.
- 10. Players may only surrender their stack at the end of registration. All chips in the player's current stack will be removed from play before they re-enter as per rule 9.
- 11. If there is an alternate list, a player that is re-entering is considered a new player and will go to the bottom of the alternate list.
- 12. Players entering after the start of the tournament acknowledges the tournament has already started, time has expired from the tournament clock and that the blinds may have been raised.
- 13. Big Blind Ante: In lieu of antes, the player that is in the big blind position will post antes for the entire table for each hand once antes are implemented. If the player posting the Big Blind and Antes has less than the full amount required for both the Big Blind and the Ante, the player will always post the Big Blind before posting the Antes and be considered all in.
- 14. Tables will be balanced within 2 players when the tournament begins. Tables will be balanced within one player when play reaches one table outside of the first prize payout. No balancing after level 11.
- 15. Prize Pool will be paid in casino chips.

- 16. The promotion drop is the amount taken from every tournament entry to fund the Poker Room promotions and is separate from, and in addition to, the house drop. The promotion drop from this tournament is \$1.
- 17. The promotion rake drop will be collected and counted in a manner consistent with the internal controls of the South Point Poker Room. One hundred percent of the promotion drop is added to the promotion reserve account daily. The promotion reserve account funds the Tournament Guarantees promotion and other poker room promotions.
- 18. You must be at least 21 years of age to participate.
- 19. Tournament Director Association ("TDA") rules will apply in all daily tournaments at the South Point. Copies of the TDA rules are available upon request as well as any variations specific to the South Point. If TDA rules do not address the issue, South Point House rules will apply.
- 20. When making a decision in the tournament the floor staff will follow TDA rules whenever possible, but will consider all circumstances when making any decision. The decisions of South Point Poker Room management regarding all aspects of this tournament are final and binding.
- 21. South Point Poker Room reserves the right to revise, cancel, modify or suspend this tournament at its sole discretion and without prior notice.
